- Finally end with your FULL name in CAPITALS and email it to write@aditisurana.com





Look for your lowercase letter t. T for tokyo, taiwan, tarzan. Lower case t is made up of two strokes - a vertical line called t stem and a horizontal line called - t bar.

A short stunted t bar shows the writer has weak willpower, whereas a long horizontal line that covers at least 3-4 letters around them, shows a strong willpower.



What does this mean?

Willpower is the strong determination that allows you to do something difficult.

- People with strong willpower show more resilience to fight the tough situations.
- They do not cave in when the going gets tough. They can push through situations. So many times their willpower inspires other people around them to be part of their vision.
